Thank you to everyone who joined us.



Ever since Midway Surgery launched Anima on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June:

- The Average Queue Time dropped by 65% meaning patients got through 3x faster
- Inbound calls had dropped by half as patients didn't need to wait in queue to request an appointment




#### **Anima Patient Guide**

1. Go to midway-surgery.co.uk




3. Choose the type of query, e.g: "health problem" for appointments





4. Fill out your details and tap "Continue" (optionally skipping verification)




5. Tap "Begin" and follow on-screen instructions







#### Flu Campaign



Each year, flu affects around 10–15% of the UK population, spreading quickly in schools and care settings. The NHS 2025–26 flu campaign uses a staggered approach: children under 18 are offered the vaccine from 1st of September, vulnerable adults from 1st of October, and those over 65 are prioritised to ensure early protection.

Stay ahead of flu, get vaccinated and keep winter healthy!
